SEASON OF CREATION

On 1 Sept 2015 Pope Francis initiated a special day of prayer for creation, to take place annually, when individuals and **communities** have an opportunity to ask God's help in protecting creation and to ask forgiveness for sins committed against the world in which we live. Pope Francis' encyclical, *Laudato Si'* published in 2015 and the inspiration for the Day of Prayer, calls on "every person living on this planet" to care for shared earth.

The ecumenical initiative, a Season for Creation, runs until the feast of St. Francis of Assisi on 4 October. It is Pope Francis's earnest desire that we should join in with this initiative and if possible, follow the Calendar for the four Sundays which fall during this period. The REMAINING ONES are :-
