Ecumenical Bible Study: The letters to the Christians at Thessalonica are thought to be the oldest letters in the New Testament perhaps written just 20 years after the events of Easter and Pentecost. In them St Paul addresses the concerns of an early community who hold a firm expectation of the second coming of Christ within their lifetime, 'the times and dates', whilst suffering persecution for their acceptance of the apostolic preaching.
