Booking for Wednesday morning Mass will now remain open until 9am each Wednesday.

SADLY, DURING THE LOCKDOWN, IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT AT MASS, THOUGH IT WILL BE LIVE-STREAMED ON WEDS. AND SUNS. ONCE LOCKDOWN HAS ENDED (WE HOPE AT THE BEGINNING OF DECEMBER), WE WILL BE INTO ADVENT.

PLEASE NOTE: IT WILL BE ESSENTIAL TO BOOK FOR MASS, EITHER ONLINE, BY USING THE LINKS ON THE WEBSITE, OR BY PHONE ON 07885 134115. WE WOULD HATE TO TURN PEOPLE AWAY, BUT WOULD HAVE NO CHOICE IF THE CHURCH HAD REACHED ITS PERMITTED LIMIT.

You can now book a 'bubble' for Mass – 3-5 people from the same household sitting in the same pew.
