A THOUGHT FROM THICKET PRIORY

Today we commemorate the 16 Blessed Martyrs of Compiègne, an entire community of Carmelite nuns who were put to death by guillotine during the French Revolution in 1794. Their story is famous through the opera Dialogues des Carmelites. There is a Yorkshire connection: the English Benedictine sisters from Cambrai were imprisoned with the Compiègne sisters and kept some of the Carmelites' clothing, bringing it back to England after their release. The few remaining fragments are now kept as relics by our sisters at Stanbrook Abbey, Wass.
