HOLY SATURDAY A day of mourning until **7.00pm The Easter Vigil**

We move outside for the Blessing of the Fire and Preparation of the Paschal Candle

Returning inside, the Exsultet (the Easter Proclamation) is sung, Mass continues, the bells ring

during the Gloria and the Water is blessed.
