**RECYCLE YOUR CABLES AT THE BACK OF CHURCH!** Did you know there is thought to be over 140 million unused cables sitting in our homes!? You could circle the Earth five times with the cables hiding in UK homes alone.

Most of us hold on to cables, charging wires and leads “just in case” but I don't know anyone that couldn't use more storage space . . . If you haven't used the cable in a year chances are, you aren't going to and you can free up valuable space by recycling your cables.

A box is provided at the back of Church by St George's Laudato Si Group in which to leave your unwanted cables for recycling at St Nicks Project in York.

**LAUDATO SI:** Laudato Si gatherings are open to anyone in the Parish, to consider the practical things we can do as a Parish to have a positive effect of the environment and how we just try to 'Live Simply'. This may include the recycling we already do at Church, helping the poor through donations to Carecent at Mass or collecting unused Phones and Mobiles to give to the IT Reuse Charity. *Prayer and reflection together is also a key foundation for the group – contact details from Fr Jo Michael.*
