SVP SUMMER CAMP: Last summer the SVP in Middlesbrough ran the first Vinnie Summer Camp at Peat Rigg Outdoor Activity Centre in Pickering, for 19 children aged between 9 and 11 (school Yrs 5 and 6). The camp is a 5 day residential break with challenging outdoor activities for children who would not otherwise benefit from such an experience. This year's camp runs from 25 to 29 August and includes year 5 and year 6 children from our schools in York. The SVP needs to raise £9,000 from across the Diocese to fund free places and transport.
