SAFEGUARDING – A REMINDER: We have been instructed by the Diocese that all volunteer in the Parish who do not require a DBS check must now complete Safeguarding training. This does not apply to any volunteer under 18 years of age. **The training requires all volunteers to read a two-page safeguarding information leaflet and then sign a form to say they have read the document.** Copies of the leaflet and the form to sign will be available at the back of church. Volunteers include Ministers of the Eucharist and the Word; Welcomers; Counters; Choir and Music Group members; Flower Arrangers; Cleaners etc. **Our Parish Safeguarding Representatives are Kevin Willis, Helen Glendinning and Lorraine Bradshaw.**

If you or a loved one is going into hospital and would like a visit, the Sacrament of the Sick, or Holy Communion, please do let your parish priest know in advance, or contact Sue Ellis, one of the Roman Catholic Chaplaincy team on her mobile 07748 108253 or contact the Chaplains' Office 01904 725579. In case of urgency, please ask the nursing staff or switchboard to page the on-call Catholic chaplain; a Catholic priest is on-call 24/7 (for urgent/emergency visits). You must ask the patient's permission before making this request.
